Region

1 Upper Peninsula Prosperity Region

Superior Connections - RCO

This Recovery Community Organization in Marquette offers peer recovery coaching, recovery and transitional housing, workforce development, and community health workers who help program participants reach goals related to social determinants of health.

Great Lakes Recovery Centers

GLRC offers a variety of recovery services at outpatient and residential locations across the UP. Services include adult recovery, child & adolescent recovery, women & families, medical & behavioral services, Medication Assisted Treatment, veterans' services, and more.

Keweenaw Bay Indian Community Substance Abuse Programs

This organization provides assessments, treatment planning, education, one-on-one and group counseling. All Native people 18 years and older living in the Bemidji Region are eligible for services without cost (funded by the Indian Health Service), non-native people are also eligible for services.

North Care Network

Pathways Community Mental Health

The UP branches of Community Mental Health offer mental health and substance use services to adults and Services are available in Escanaba, Munising, Marquette, and Newberry (primarily the 1b prosperity region).

2 Northwest Prosperity Region	<p><u>217 Recovery – RCO</u> This Traverse City-based RCO provides coaching, recovery meetings, rides to local services, resources, and hosts a recovery-focused podcast.</p> <p><u>Community Recovery Alliance - RCO</u> This Petosky-based RCO offers re-entry supports, recovery coaching, recovery-friendly workplace training, recovery resources, and a newly opened Recovery Community Center.</p> <p><u>Harm Reduction Michigan – RCO</u> This Traverse City RCO provides harm reduction and overdose prevention education and training at introductory and advanced levels.</p> <p><u>Alcona Health Center Recovery Services</u> This healthcare organization offers the following recovery services to patients already established in its network: MAT, counseling, care coordination, and physical healthcare needs.</p> <p><u>Bear River Health</u> This recovery organization offers detoxification, residential services, Medication Assisted Treatment, outpatient services and ongoing recovery support in the Northern Michigan area (primarily Charlevoix and Emmet counties).</p>



	<p><u>Catholic Human Services</u> This organization offers outpatient SUD services for adults, adolescents, and families. Services include individual and group therapy, family counseling, peer recovery support, care coordination, post overdose response, and <i>referrals</i> to other organizations that offer Medication Assisted Treatment.</p> <p><u>Northern Michigan Regional Entity (NMRE)</u> NMRE is one of the state’s Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans (PIHP) for people enrolled in Medicaid. They offer a SUD provider directory, women’s specialty services for SUD treatment, an Opioid Health Home program, and <u>SUD prevention resources</u> for northern Michigan.</p>
3 Northeast Prosperity Region	<p><u>Alcona Health Center Recovery Services</u> This healthcare organization offers the following recovery services to patients already established in its network: MAT, counseling, care coordination, and physical healthcare needs.</p> <p><u>Bear River Health</u> This recovery organization offers detoxification, residential services, Medication Assisted Treatment, outpatient services and ongoing recovery support in the Northern Michigan area (primarily Otsego and Cheboygan counties).</p> <p><u>Catholic Human Services</u> This organization offers outpatient SUD services for adults, adolescents, and families. Services include individual and group therapy, family counseling, peer recovery support, care coordination, post overdose response, and <i>referrals</i> to other organizations that offer Medication Assisted Treatment.</p> <p><u>Northern Michigan Regional Entity (NMRE)</u> NMRE is one of the state’s Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans (PIHP) for people enrolled in Medicaid. 4 West Michigan Prosperity Alliance	<p><u>Life Align, Inc – RCO</u> This non-profit hosts community events, recovery coaching, and weekly meetings, support groups, and mediations.</p> <p><u>Arbor Circle</u> Arbor Circle offers long-term recovery management services, recovery group counseling, substance use assessments, and specialty services for women, veterans, and people who are incarcerated.</p> <p><u>Grand Rapids Area Substance Use Disorder Treatment Resource Guide - Michigan Substance Use, Prevention, Education and Recovery (MiSUPER) (msu.edu)</u> This site provides various resources (e.g., medical health, family support/education, behavioral health, inpatient services, etc.) and a description of each resource is provided as well.</p> <p><u>Wedgwood Christian Services</u> This Christian non-profit and healthcare ministry provides recovery services to adults and adolescents. Services include recovery coaching, outpatient services, intensive outpatient care, women & family specialty services, Medication Assisted Treatment, and residential treatment for adolescents.</p> <p><u>West Michigan Community Mental Health</u> Services include outpatient therapy, care management, peer recovery coaching, Medication Assisted Treatment, withdrawal management services, and residential treatment.</p>



5 East Central Michigan Prosperity Region	<p><u>Peer 360 Recovery Alliance - RCO</u> This organization provides awareness-raising videos, calendars for finding support group meetings and alcohol/drug free social events, and recovery coaching training.</p> <p><u>Bay Arenac Behavioral Health</u> Services include Naloxone distribution, SUD resources, and a list of local SUD treatment and prevention providers in the bay area.</p> <p><u>Community Mental Health for Central Michigan</u> Eligibility for services requires that an individual has both a serious mental illness as well as a substance use disorder. Services include assessment and referral, intensive outpatient treatment, Methadone and LAAM Treatment, and sub-acute detoxification.</p> <p><u>Ten16 Recovery Network</u> This mid-Michigan organization offers residential treatment, outpatient counseling, recovery coaching and support, and recovery housing.</p> <p><u>Flint Area Substance Use Disorder Treatment Resource Guide</u> Provides various resources for those living in Mid-Michigan.</p>
6 East Michigan Prosperity Region	<p><u>Blue Water Recovery and Outreach Center - RCO</u> This nonprofit helps connect people with SUD concerns in St. Clair County to treatment providers and local support groups. They also offer resources, outreach, events, and workplace recovery education training.</p> <p><u>Flint Serenity House - RCO</u> Serenity House focuses on SUD prevention and advocacy efforts. They offer peer recovery coaching and recovery-focused wellness programs and events in the Flint area including yoga and Reiki.</p> <p><u>Genesee Community Health Center</u> This health center provides the following services in Genesee County: Medication Assisted Therapy, brief</p>



	<p>interventions, Narcan and Narcan training, and recovery coaching.</p> <p><u>Thumb Opioid Response Consortium</u> This consortium in the thumb area helps people find providers and recovery support groups in their county (Huron, Lapeer, Sanilac, & Tuscola). They also have resources about the opioid crisis and some PSAs.</p>
7 South Central Prosperity Region	<p><u>Lifeboat – RCO</u> This Lansing organization provides local resources and recovery support meetings. They also offer trainings and free Narcan. Their Rapid Response program is an opioid overdose response team that serves Ingham County.</p> <p><u>RISE Recovery Community - RCO</u> This Lansing-based organization offers supportive housing, peer recovery coaching, support for families, and a local directory for individuals to search for providers and services.</p> <p><u>Community Mental Health for Clinton, Eaton, & Ingham</u> This region’s CMH offers detox services, residential and outpatient recovery services, integrated healthcare, and mental health and substance use services for individuals who are incarcerated.</p> <p><u>Lansing Area Substance Use Disorder Treatment Resource Guide - Michigan Substance Use, Prevention, Education and Recovery (MiSUPER) (msu.edu)</u> This site provides various resources (e.g., medical health, family support/education, behavioral health, inpatient services, etc.) and a description of each resource is provided as well.</p> <p><u>Mid-Michigan Recovery Services</u> The capitol area organization offers early intervention and support groups, outpatient and residential treatment services, recovery coaching, and Safe Harbor recovery housing.</p>



8 Southwest Prosperity Region	<p><u>New Way 365 – RCO</u> This RCO offers treatment and recovery support group resources for the Berrien County area.</p> <p><u>Integrated Services of Kalamazoo</u> This organization offers counseling and peer recovery support services for adults; they also work closely with healthcare and mental health providers and housing resources in the Kalamazoo area to help meet the needs of individuals.</p> <p><u>Landmark Recovery of West Michigan</u> This Battle Creek treatment center offers medical detox, residential services, and outpatient treatment.</p> <p><u>Recovery Institute of Southwest Michigan</u> This nonprofit is a peer support recovery community that offers classes, one-on-ones, and social outings. They also provide directories for local organizations and community resources for Kalamazoo County.</p> <p>Southwest Michigan Behavioral Health <u>Home Southwest Michigan Behavioral Health (swmbh.org)</u> SWMBH provides mental health and recovery services and can connect individuals with providers. They also have an Opioid Health Home program in which individuals are supported by a care team that helps them to reach personalized recovery goals.</p>
9 Southeast Prosperity Region	<p><u>Jackson Area Recovery Community - RCO</u> This RCO offers community education and advocacy, as well as peer recovery coaching and meetings and events for folks in recovery.</p> <p><u>Recovery Advocacy Warriors - RCO</u> This RCO provides information and training on Naloxone and recovery coaching. They also provide recovery resources and volunteer opportunities in the Southeast Michigan area.</p> <p><u>Recovery Advocates in Livingston – RCO</u></p>



This Brighton-based RCO offers recovery groups, case management, employment services, resource coordination, and training opportunities for people in recovery and community professionals. They also host family support groups and sober social activities.

Washtenaw Recovery Advocacy Project - RCO

This RCO advocates for people and families impacted by substance use. They offer free Naloxone and Naloxone training, recovery coaching, volunteer opportunities, and local recovery meetings and events.

Ann Arbor District Library's downtown branch installed a Narcan vending machine

All public libraries in Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti provide Naloxone available for free.

CARE of Southeastern Michigan (careofsem.com)

Provides substance abuse prevention and recovery.

Drug Free Jackson

This community coalition works on substance use disorder prevention and spreading awareness of local resources such as treatment and counseling options, support groups, and locations at which Naloxone is available.

Smart Recovery

This organization supports those in recovery and those closet to those in recovery as well as for those who are currently in prison, military, first responders, and veterans as well. There are weekly in person meetings and various types of resources (e.g., toolkits, handbook, training, etc.) are included on their website.

Home of the new Vision

This organization offers Michigan Certification Board for Addiction Professionals (MCBAP) approved training and educational opportunities and provides gender-specific programs and specialized programs for those in recovery and their loved ones.



10 Detroit Metro Prosperity Region

Detroit Recovery Project - RCO

Supports those who are in recovery and those experiencing co-occurring mental health and SUD.

Live Rite Structured Recovery Corps - RCO

This RCO offers support for housing, clothing, food, employment searches, peer recovery coaching, and support meetings to people in recovery. They provide local resources and education and training as well.

Passenger Recovery – RCO

This RCO offers support groups and peer coaching (and transportation for those services), as well as a tool for finding local meetings.

Recovery United Community Center - RCO

This group hosts recovery events and programs, Naloxone training, and coaching. They also provide information on local mental health access centers and residential treatment providers.

All Well-Being Services – Bringing Wellness to Life (awbs.org)

Provides services such as SUD treatment and education.

Centro Multicultural La Familia

Provides counseling and support groups for substance abuse and mental health.
